

7 THINGS GOD WILL NEVER FORGET

FIRST, it must be stressed the importance of TRULY knowing God, and continuing to GROW in the [experiential] knowledge of God. Otherwise—no matter how long we have been a believer—we might start to drift from a proper knowledge of God as revealed in the Bible.

7 THINGS GOD WILL NEVER FORGET:

1). **GOD WILL NEVER FORGET** “His own name” (aka Who He is); and “the glory” of Who He is. He is the Holy and Sovereign Creator God, Who dwells in unapproachable light; YET He is also the merciful and gracious Lord.

—Isaiah 54:5; I John 1:5; (yet also) Exodus 34:5-7; Malachi 3:6; Lamentations 3:22; Hosea 11:1-9

2). **GOD WILL NEVER FORGET YOU** and His promise and purpose for YOUR life.

—Isaiah 49:15; Hebrews 13:5, Psalm 139:7-10; Joshua 1:9; Jeremiah 29:11

3). **GOD WILL NEVER FORGET** that we—“fallen man”—are but dust.

(for while he commands us to never forget Him, the sad reality is that we do—Jeremiah 2:32)

—Psalm 103:14, Matthew 26:41, Hebrews 4:15-16; Psalm 73:26

4). **GOD WILL NEVER FORGET** the work of His Son on the cross, and what it did for us as sinners.

—II Corinthians 5:21; Isaiah 53:10-11; John 19:30; Genesis 9:6

5). **GOD WILL NEVER FORGET** our personal sorrows.

—Exodus 3:7; Psalm 22:24; Psalm 56:8; Isaiah 63:9; Psalm 66:12; I Peter 5:10

5). **GOD WILL NEVER FORGET** what we have done for His name and in His name.

—Hebrews 6:10; I Corinthians 15:58; Matthew 10:42; Matthew 26:13; Matthew 25:40

6). **GOD WILL NEVER FORGET** to provide us new graces and mercies every morning.

—Lamentations 3:23

7). **God KNOWS ALL, YET HE CHOOSES TO FORGET OUR SINS** when they have been confessed to Him. HE will even restore ALL that sin has robbed us of and wasted in our lives.
